- Follow under self-imposed sanctions consisting of no on-campus social events, a revised and enforced risk management process and manual, host a fall retreat where general fraternity staff have been invited to attend, and a strict review of philanthropy events and their progress.
- Be limited to two off-campus social events for the fall term, both of which must be supervised by alumni members.
- Retain an alcohol free residence during the Fall 2007 semester.
- And the lowering to Stage I probation for the Spring term if the chapter is in compliance with the above said terms.
